- **Information you provide** – When we ask you for personal information (such as your name, email address, phone number, credit card and billing address or other payment information) this information is being processed through PCI Data Security's global standards of practice to protect cardholder data recommended by; Wells Fargo/Wachovia internet merchant services department.
